Welcome to the April edition of our Staff Senate newsletter! This month, we had significant discussions that will shape the future of our Senate.

We discussed the need to balance out roll-off membership for this year to avoid a mass exodus and provide continuity between years in a 3-year period. We are considering changing the number of senators rolling off each term so that only 10-12 senators roll off each year out of the 33 senators.

We are exploring the idea of having some senators roll off now and allowing them to run for next year's senate to serve a new 3-year term. Our hope is that this would help maintain a balance in our Senate.

We had a robust discussion on how to balance representation. One suggestion was that a person from the Staff Senate would represent multiple departments. We also discussed the possibility of adding new representatives instead of people rolling off and being re-elected. We hope to cap the number of senators around 30.

These discussions are ongoing, and no decisions have been made. We encourage you to share your thoughts and attend our upcoming meeting on May 13 in the Johnson Library.
